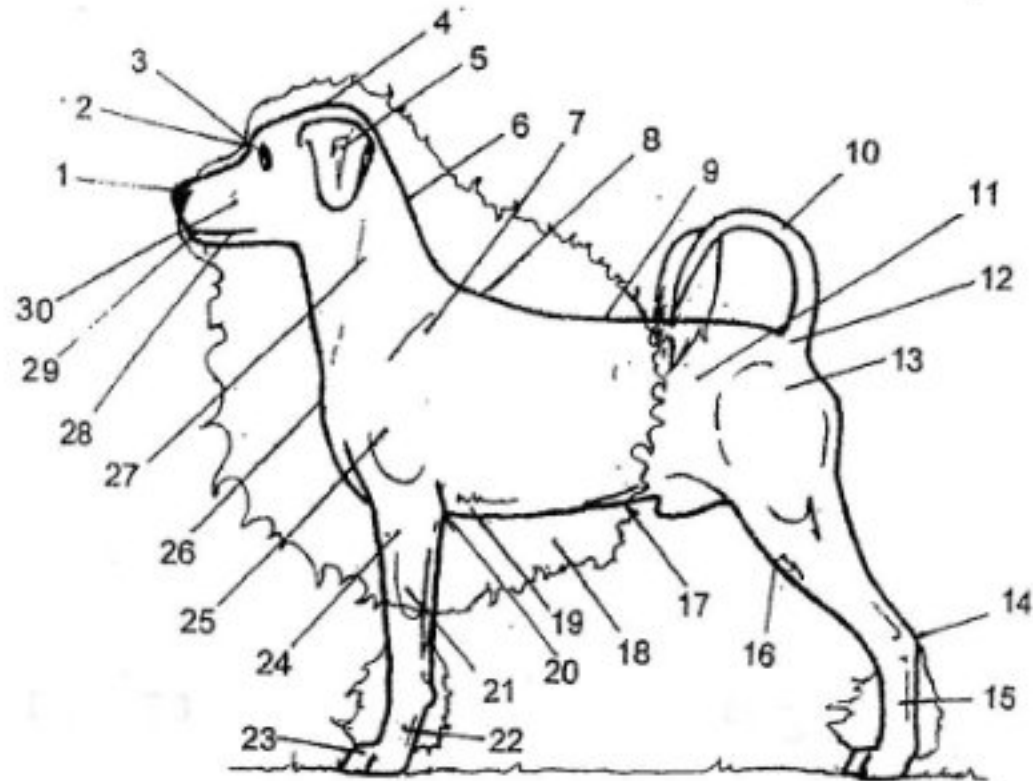


Parts That Are Mentioned In The Standard

1. Nose – Dark black or brown depending on the coat color
2. Eyes – Large, dark, round, set well into skull, forward looking, (meaning not slanting on the sides of the head).
3. Stop – moderate
4. Back skull – broad, relatively flat
5. Ears – pendant, set on slightly above the eye
6. Neck – slight arch
7. Shoulder blade – well laid back
8. Height – 11" – 13" at withers
9. Topline – level
10. Tail – carried in a cup handle fashion
11. Loin – Short strong
12. Tail set – set high
13. Pelvis – pelvic bone projects beyond at an approx. 30 degree angle
14. Hocks – well let down
15. Rear pastern – perpendicular
16. Stifle – Well bent
17. Tuck up – slight
18. Coat – The untrimmed coat is long, moderately soft In texture with a slight wave. Any trim other than specified is a disqualification.
19. Brisket – level with the elbow
20. Elbow – close to the body
21. Foreleg – more round than oval
22. Front pasterns – short, slightly bent
23. Feet – arched with deep pads
24. Bone – Strong and sturdy
25. Upper arm – Equal length to shoulder blade
26. Fore chest – Measuring point
27. Neck – Good length
28. Lips – Tight and dark
29. Teeth – scissor, complete dentition, large and well-spaced
30. Muzzle – measurement from nose to stop is approximately 2/3 of the measurement from stop to occiput.
